FROM FR. GEORGE....

New Year's Day is a time when many people rethink their lives and want to make a fresh start. Do you ever make new Year's resolutions? Many people do, and the most popular seem to involve trying to rid one's life of some unwanted attachment or behavior. People make resolutions to lose weight, quit smoking or drinking, reduce stress, get out of debt, or keep the house clean. These are all helpful goals to try to achieve, but many people are not successful because they know what they don't want in their lives, but have not completely formed in their minds what it is they really do want. Without a well-formed outcome in their mind's eye, they tend to slip back to old behaviors pretty quickly. One needs a good solid idea of where they are going, a destination in mind, to make the journey worthwhile. Every year I get this idea that I am going to lose 35 pounds and look skinny and handsome as I was when I was a teenager. Uh. It hasn't happened.

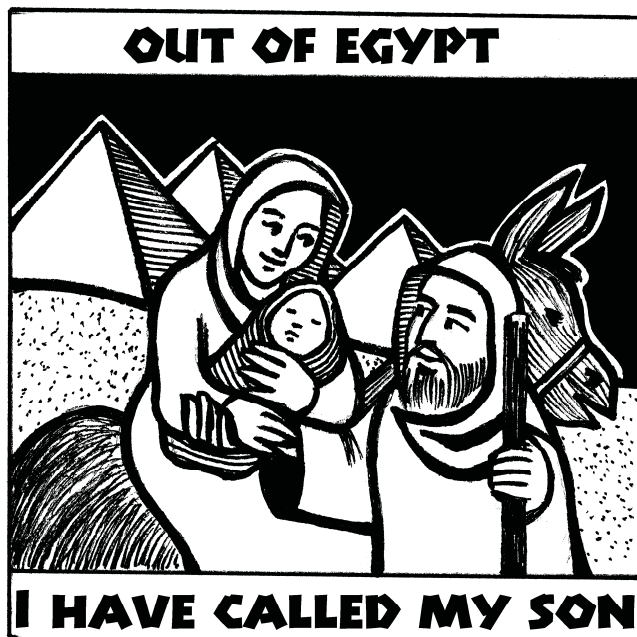
Give - Can you imagine taking from your abundance of treasure, time, and talent to benefit God's creation?

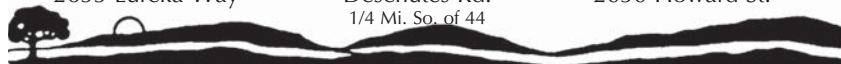

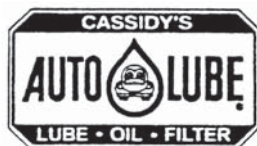
